



Deschutes State Recreation Area

PARK TRAILS

Blackberry-Riverview Loop 3 miles

Single-track, 24" trail with river views.

Ferry Springs 1.3 miles

Single-track, 24" inch trail to Ferry Springs viewpoint and through Ferry Springs Canyon. Abundant spring wildflowers.

Deschutes River 13 miles

Wide, gravel path follows route of old railbed along Deschutes River. Horses by reservation March 1 - June 30.

Rock Pile 2 miles

Unmaintained beyond mile 2.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Backcountry campfires are prohibited June 1-Oct. 15 unless otherwise noted. Bureau of Land Management regulations prohibit collecting firewood and building a fire pit; use a fire pan.

Park trails are remote with limited emergency services; tell someone your plans and carry plenty of water.

Hunting is allowed at trail mile 1 (beyond the cable crossing); no hunting the third Saturday in May through Aug. 31.

Horseback riding is allowed March 1-June 30 by reservation via store.oregonstateparks.org. Overnight camping with horses is prohibited.

All river use requires a boater permit.

Backcountry camping allowed past mile 2 (Rattlesnake Rapid).

Rattlesnakes and ticks live here. Leave snakes be; they will not bite unless threatened. Ticks are most active in spring and early summer. Avoid long grass and brush during tick season.

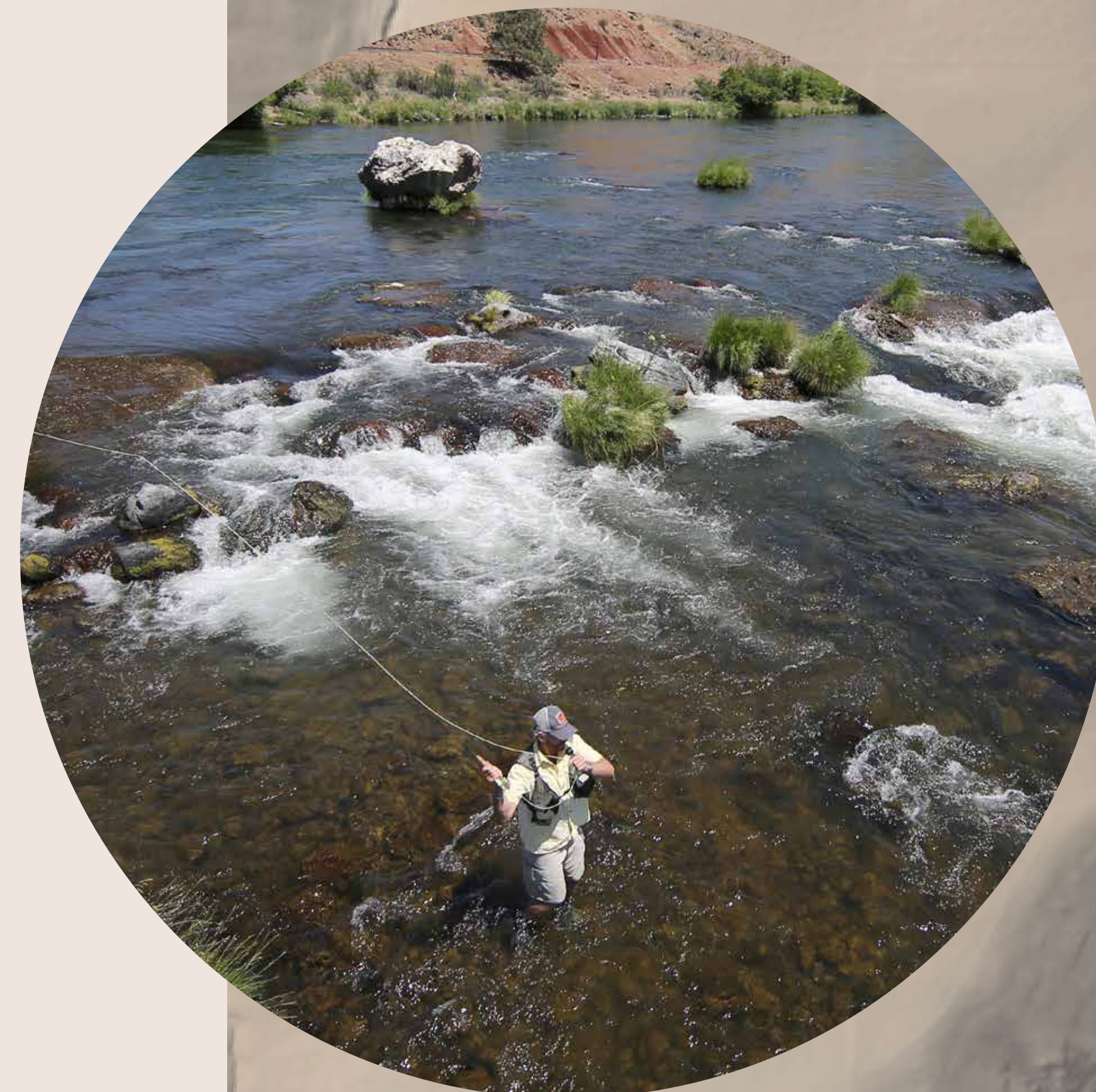
