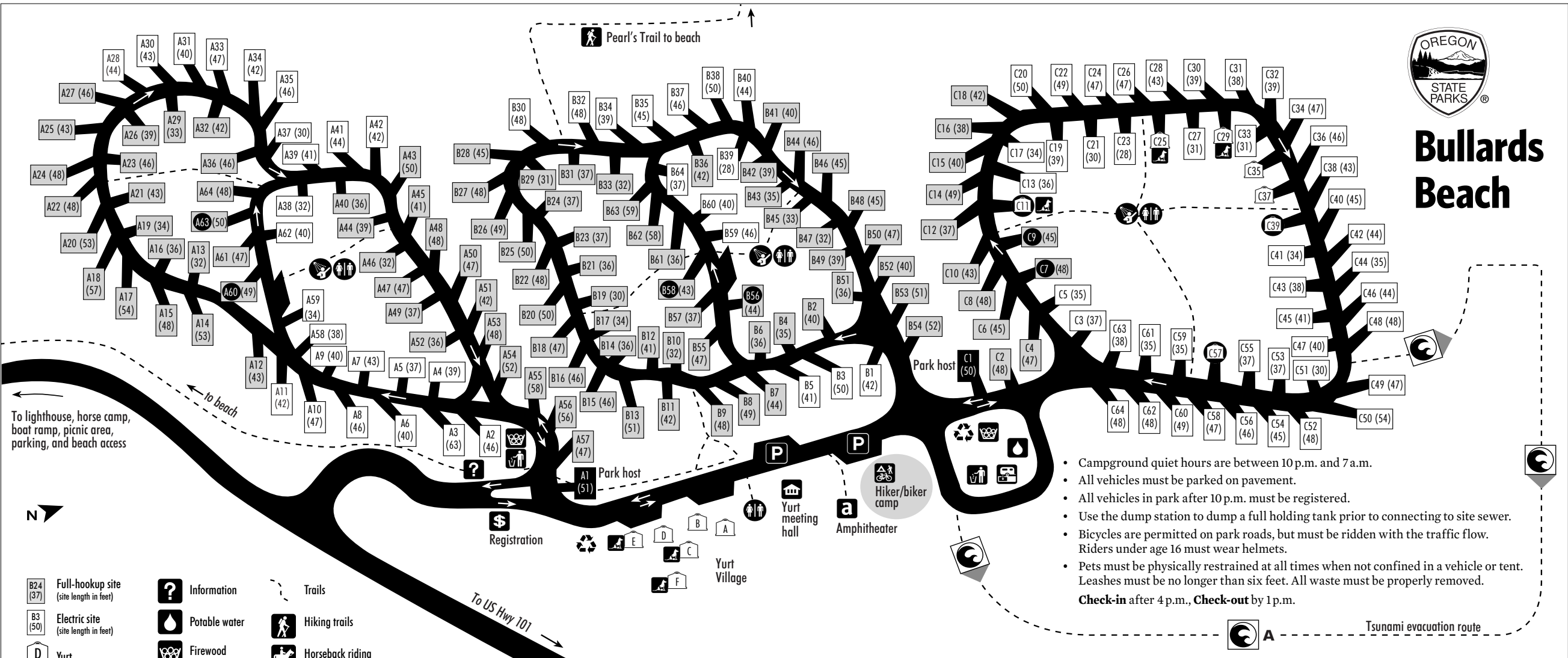




Bullards Beach



To lighthouse, horse camp, boat ramp, picnic area, parking, and beach access

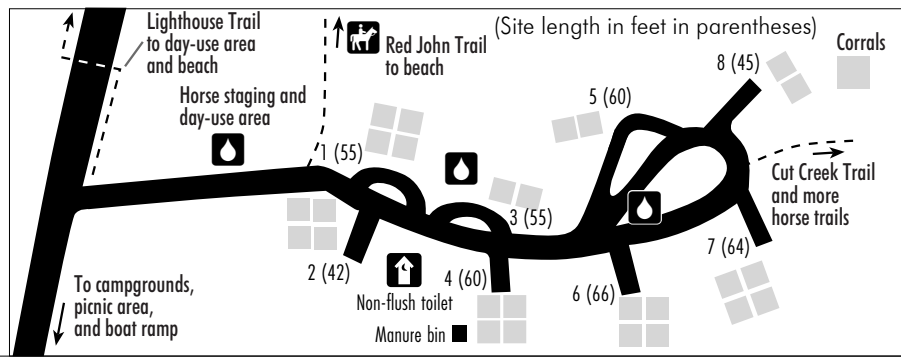

Play it safe on the beach!
Stay off logs, know the tide schedule,
and don't turn your back on the ocean.

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
 - All vehicles in park after 10 p.m. must be registered.
 - Use the dump station to dump a full holding tank prior to connecting to site sewer.
 - Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but must be ridden with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
 - Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed.
- Check-in** after 4 p.m., **Check-out** by 1p.m.

Horse Camp

- Tethering horses outside of corrals is not permitted.
- Only one horse is allowed in each corral.
- Occupant responsible for removing straw and manure from site.
- Fires are permitted only in the fire rings provided.
- Ride on designated trails and along the beach only.
- Stay off paved trails and roadways.
- Please dispose properly of all waste.
- Only people with a horse or similar large animal may occupy a horse campsite.



Bullards Beach Campground Guidelines

Vehicles

- All vehicles must be parked on asphalt in designated areas and display a valid parking pass at all times.
- Motorized vehicles are limited to two per site. Only one RV or sleeping unit is allowed per site.
- Starting or operating ATVs in the campground is prohibited.

Quiet Hours

- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. – 7 a.m. and are strictly enforced. Please be courteous to your campground neighbors and turn off all amplified sound after 10 p.m.

Trash And Recycling

- Take all garbage and recyclable materials to the trash compactor and recycling center near the registration booth. Do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or at your campsite.

Pets

- Pets must be leashed at all times in the campground; maximum leash length is six feet.
- Off leash areas are available; ask a park ranger or host for more information.
- Please clean up after your dog. Find free pet waste bags at one of the pet stations in the campground.
- Pets are not allowed in restrooms.

Food

- Please ensure your food is stowed in a secure, hard-sided container. Squirrels, raccoons and crows can tear through plastic food and garbage bags. Some have even been able to open unsecured coolers and ice chests.

Please report campground issues to park staff at the registration booth. If it is after hours or the booth is closed, please contact the on-duty park hosts in site A-1 or C-1.
