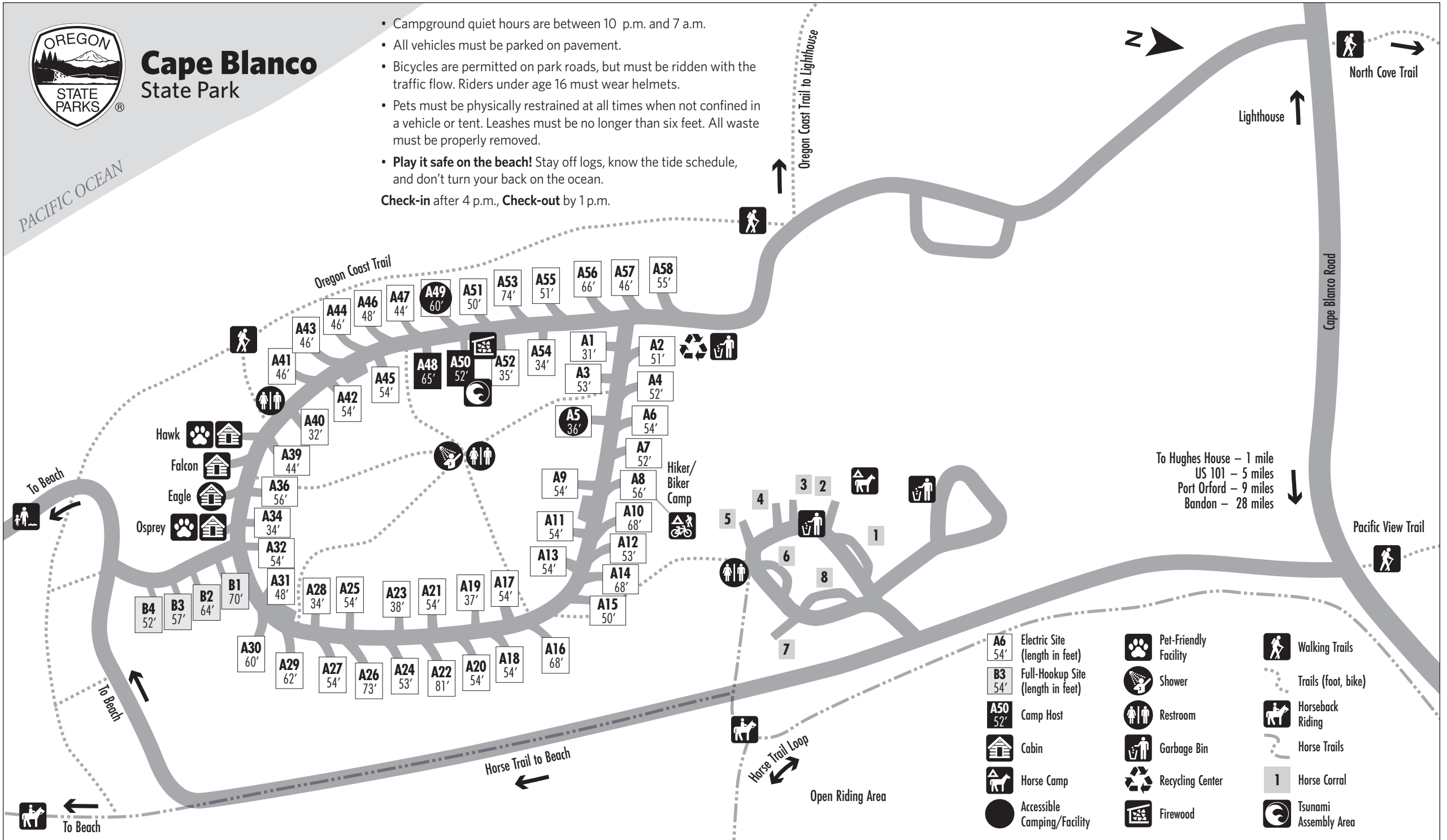




Cape Blanco State Park

PACIFIC OCEAN

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
 - Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but must be ridden with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
 - Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed.
 - **Play it safe on the beach!** Stay off logs, know the tide schedule, and don't turn your back on the ocean.
- Check-in after 4 p.m., Check-out by 1 p.m.**

CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

Thefts can occur night or day. Secure all your gear, coolers and hitches.

SITE PAYMENT

Please remember that your campsite/extra vehicle fee must be **paid in full within 30 minutes** after arrival. Pay at the booth near site A50. All sites must be reserved online prior to occupancy with the exception of hiker/biker and horse camp.

PARKING AND EXTRA VEHICLES

- If space allows, a second vehicle may be accommodated for an additional charge per night.
- Campers must display a valid camping or extra vehicle permit on dash of all vehicles.
- All vehicles/trailers must be parked on pavement.
- Vehicles that do not fit on paved pad in campsite may park at extra vehicle parking areas near sites 9, 31, and 42 if space allows and with valid camping permit displayed on dash.

Limit of two vehicles per site. Site fee covers one vehicle, including towed vehicle.

DISABLED VETERANS/FOSTER PARENTS

We accept the **Oregon State Parks Special Access Pass**. A park ranger will need to verify the pass number. If you have questions about your pass

or would like information on getting a pass, speak to a park ranger or the park host on duty.

RECYCLE AND WASTE STATION

Take all garbage and recyclables to compactor and recycling area across from site A58. **Do not burn garbage.** Please do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or at your campsite. For your convenience, there are sink waste disposals throughout the campground.

FIREWOOD SALES

Purchase firewood from the on-duty park host in sites A48 or A50. Exact change or credit card. No firewood sales after 8 p.m. Do not leave your campfires unattended and please extinguish them completely prior to departure.

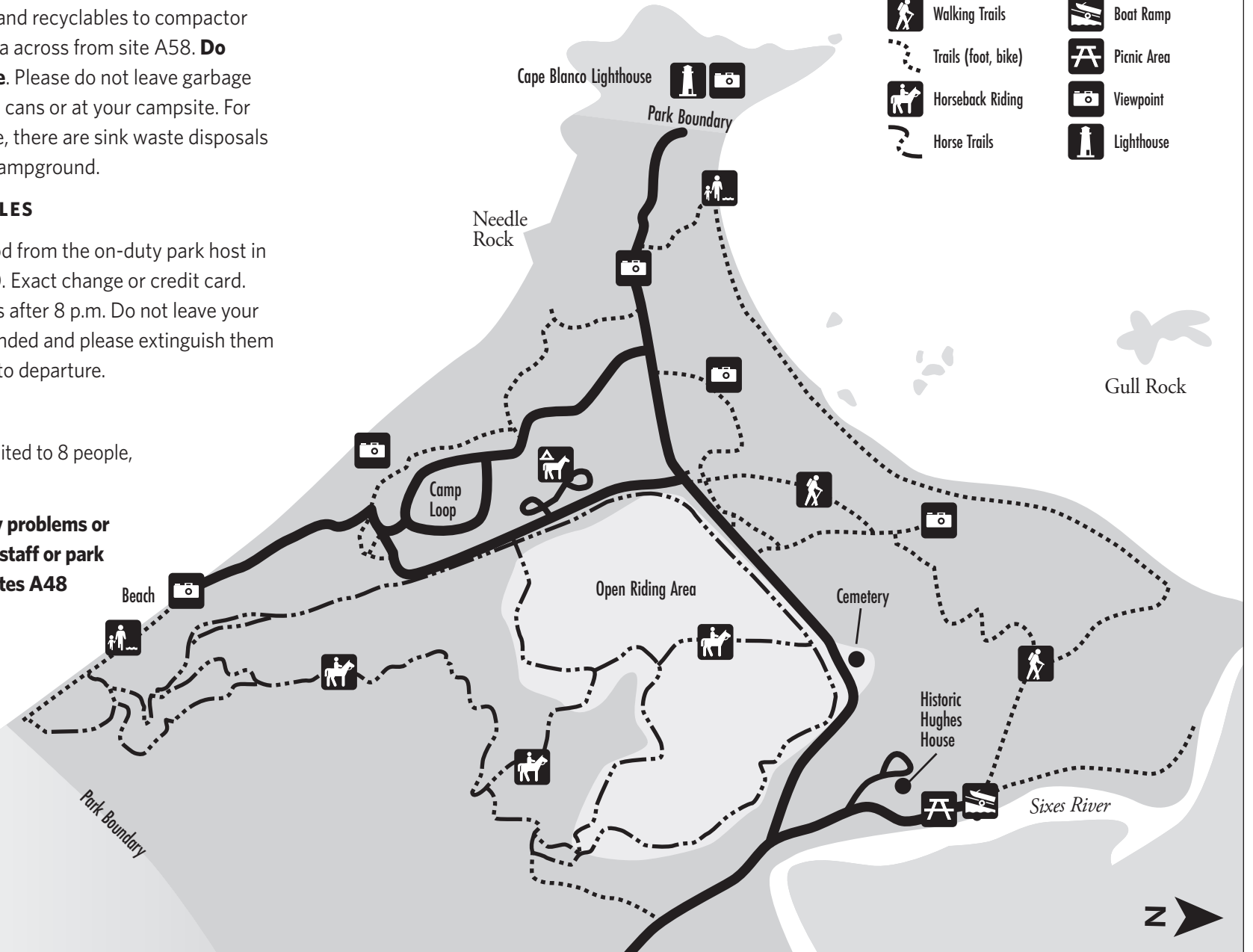
OCCUPANCY
