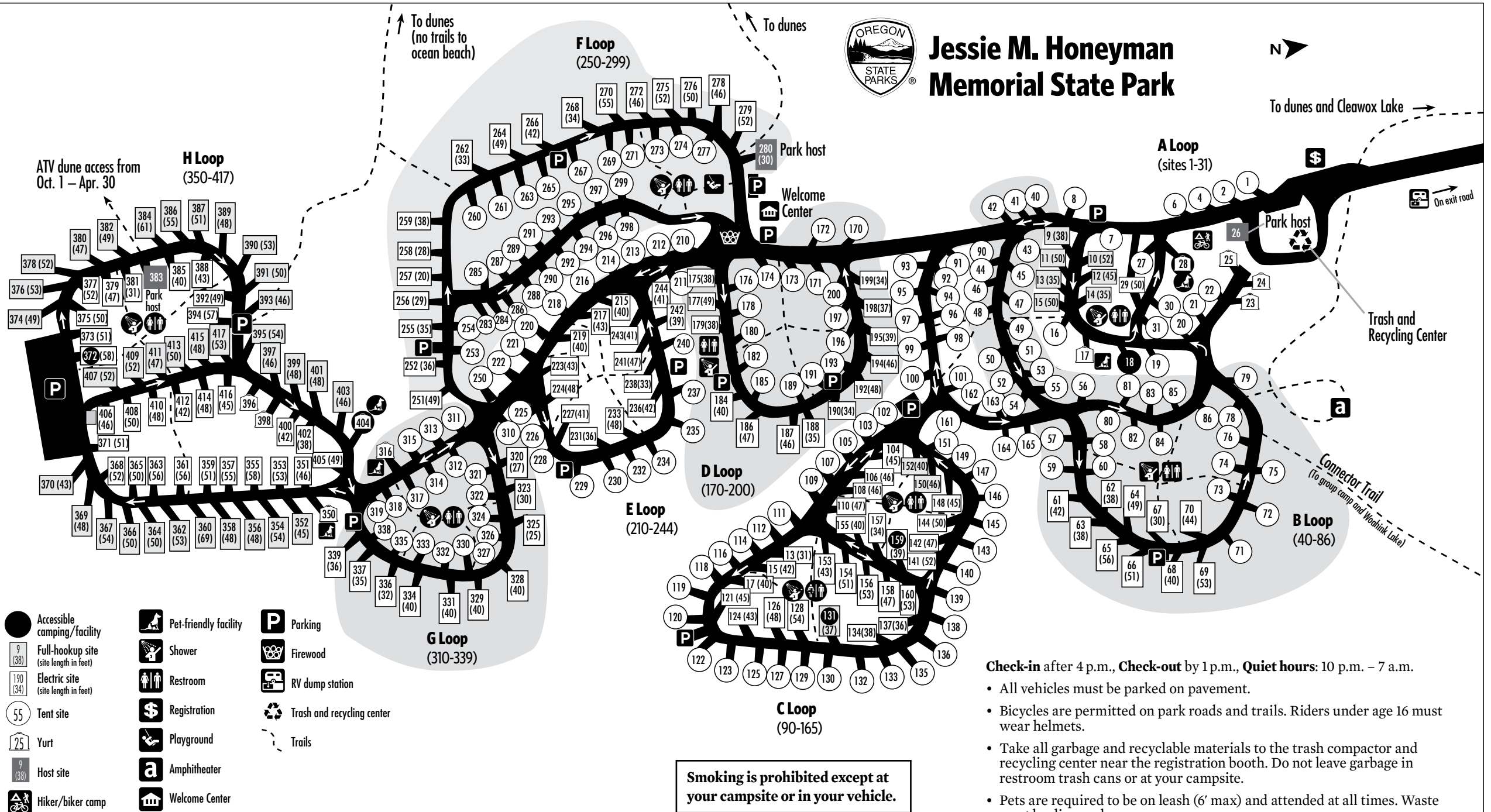




Jessie M. Honeyman Memorial State Park



Smoking is prohibited except at your campsite or in your vehicle.

Check-in after 4 p.m., **Check-out** by 1 p.m., **Quiet hours:** 10 p.m. – 7 a.m.

- All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
- Bicycles are permitted on park roads and trails. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- Take all garbage and recyclable materials to the trash compactor and recycling center near the registration booth. Do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or at your campsite.
- Pets are required to be on leash (6' max) and attended at all times. Waste must be disposed.
- **Play it safe on the beach!** Stay off logs, know the tide schedule, and don't turn your back on the ocean.

Honeyman Campground Guidelines



ALERT: Thefts can occur night or day. Secure all gear, coolers, and bicycles.

Parking and Extra Vehicles

- All vehicles must display a valid camping receipt or extra vehicle permit.
- All vehicles and trailers (anything with wheels) must be parked on the asphalt.
- A maximum of two vehicles are allowed per registered site.
- A second vehicle can be accommodated for an extra charge per night. For additional parking, purchase additional campsites.
- All ATVs must remain loaded. (Exception: when using toy haulers, ATVs may be placed next to a trailer on asphalt but may not be started to do so. This only applies if unloading is required to sleep).
- **ATVs may not be started in the campground.**

Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are 10 p.m. – 7 a.m. and are strictly enforced. Noise producing devices must be turned off by 10 p.m. Noise disruptions may be cause for eviction from the park and/or citations.

Pets

Pets must remain on a 6' leash in all state parks and may **never be left unattended**. **Please clean up** after pets; doggie bags are provided for your convenience. Pets are not allowed in facilities unless stated otherwise.

Payment

Payment of site and vehicle fees are due within 30 minutes of arrival. Pay at the registration booth.

Trash and Recycling Center

Take all garbage and recyclable materials to the trash compactor and recycling center near the registration booth. Do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or at your campsite.

Food

Please make sure your food is stored in a secure container. Wildlife can tear through food and garbage bags.

Firewood

Purchase firewood at the Welcome Center. Please don't collect branches or cut living plants! Help preserve nature in your state parks.

Bicyclists and Skaters

Serious accidents happen each summer at Honeyman. Keep you and your family safe: obey all signs, ride on the right and travel at a slow pace. Oregon law requires that anyone younger than 16 wear a helmet.

Please report problems or concerns to park staff at the registration booth. After hours, contact a park host.
