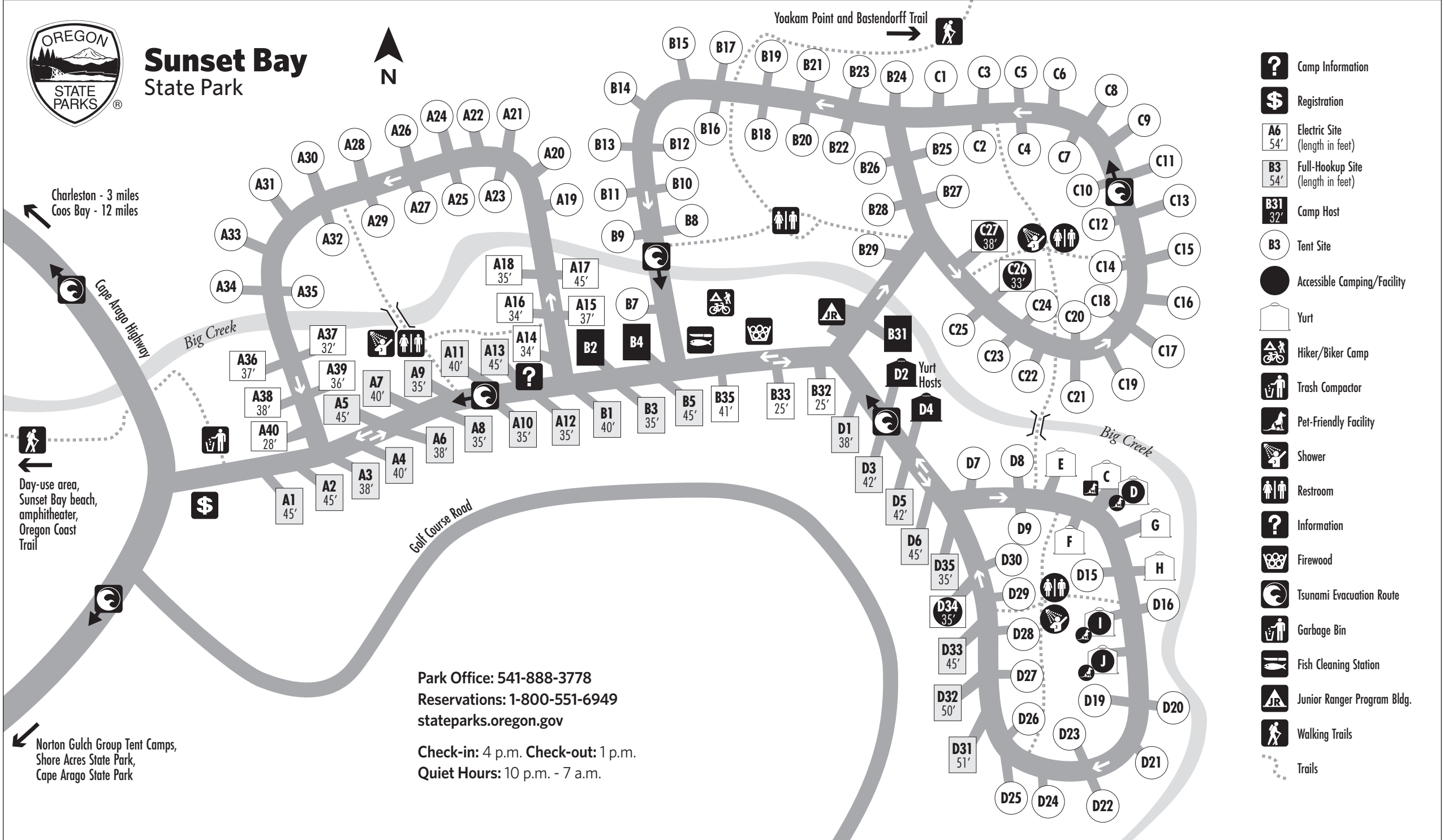

CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

PAYMENT

Site and vehicle fees are due within 30 minutes of arrival. Pay at the registration station at the park entrance.

YURTS

Cooking and smoking are prohibited inside yurts. Cats and dogs are allowed in pet-friendly yurts only (C, D, I, J). Up to two pets allowed for an additional per-night fee.

VEHICLES

- Two vehicles (including tow vehicle) are allowed per site. Extra vehicles are charged a per-night fee.
- All vehicles must fit on pavement within your campsite and display a valid receipt.
- No overflow parking available.

TRASH & RECYCLING

A trash compactor and recycling station are located near the registration booth. Please bring all garbage and recycling to this location and do not burn garbage or put it in restroom cans.

FOOD

Store food in secure containers. Squirrels, raccoons and crows can tear through food and garbage bags.

FIREWOOD

Purchase firewood from park hosts in sites B2 or B4. Don't collect branches or cut living plants for firewood.

BICYCLING AND SKATING

- Follow safety rules: obey signs, ride on the right, ride with the traffic flow.
- Helmets required for those 16 and younger.
- Motorized scooters are not permitted.

SMOKING POLICY

Smoking in Oregon State Parks is allowed only in personal vehicles, RV's and campsites.

THEFT

Thefts are rare but can occur night or day. Secure your vehicle and gear.

PETS

- Pets must remain on a leash (6' max) and under control on all state park property.
- Please clean up after your pet and never leave it unattended.
- Pets are not allowed in restrooms or yurts, except for pet-friendly yurts.

BEACH SAFETY

Play it safe on the beach. Stay off logs, know the tide schedule, and don't turn your back on the ocean.
