CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

VEHICLES

- All vehicles must be parked on asphalt and display a valid receipt.
- If a vehicle does not fit on the asphalt pad, it must be parked in **overflow parking**, indicated on the map.

FIREWOOD SALES

Limited availability. Please see information kiosks at campground restrooms for current hours. Firewood is also available in the towns of Rogue River and Gold Hill.

FIRE PITS

Please burn firewood only. Burning pallets, trash, plastic or glass is prohibited.

FOOD

Food should be stowed in secure containers. Squirrels and crows will tear through food and garbage bags.

TRASH & RECYCLING

Dumpsters are available in C and F loops and trash cans are in A Loop. Recycling is not available at this time.

PETS

- Pets must remain on a leash with a maximum length of six feet.
- Please **clean up** after your pet and **never leave it unattended**.
- Bags are provided for your convenience near host sites in each camp loop.
- Pets are not allowed in restrooms or yurts, except for pet-friendly yurts.

RIVER ACCESS

The river is swift and cold; please be careful.

Small Children:

- The boat ramp
- Between B & D loops, off River's Edge Trail

Teenagers/Adults:

Walk River's Edge Trail, you will see many foot paths towards river

INTERPRETIVE EVENTS

Programs are held May-September. Please see information kiosks at campground restrooms for details.
