CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

VEHICLES

- Maximum of 3 vehicles in campsite at any time.
- One RV allowed per campsite.
- All additional vehicles will be charged an extra vehicle fee of \$7 per night.
- All vehicles must be parked on asphalt and display a valid receipt.
- If a vehicle does not fit on the asphalt pad, it must be parked in the **visitor parking lot**, indicated on the map.

FIREWOOD

- Available until 8 p.m.
- \$5 a bundle
- Purchase at host sites A-6, B-3, C-51 and D-49

FIRE PITS

Please burn **only** wood – no trash, plastic or glass.

FOOD

Food should be stowed in secure containers. Squirrels and crows will tear through food and garbage bags.

PETS

- Pets must remain on a leash with a maximum length of six feet.
- Dog off leash area is located across from “C” loop entrance.
- Please **clean up** after your pet and **never leave it unattended**.
- Bags are provided for your convenience near host sites in each camp loop.

LAKE ACCESS

- The lake is **not** accessible from the campground.
- The day-use area has a swim beach, boat ramp and marina.

TRASH & RECYCLING

A trash compactor is located by the dump station. Restroom receptacles are for restroom trash only. Recycle your plastic and aluminum cans and bottles by the trash compactor.

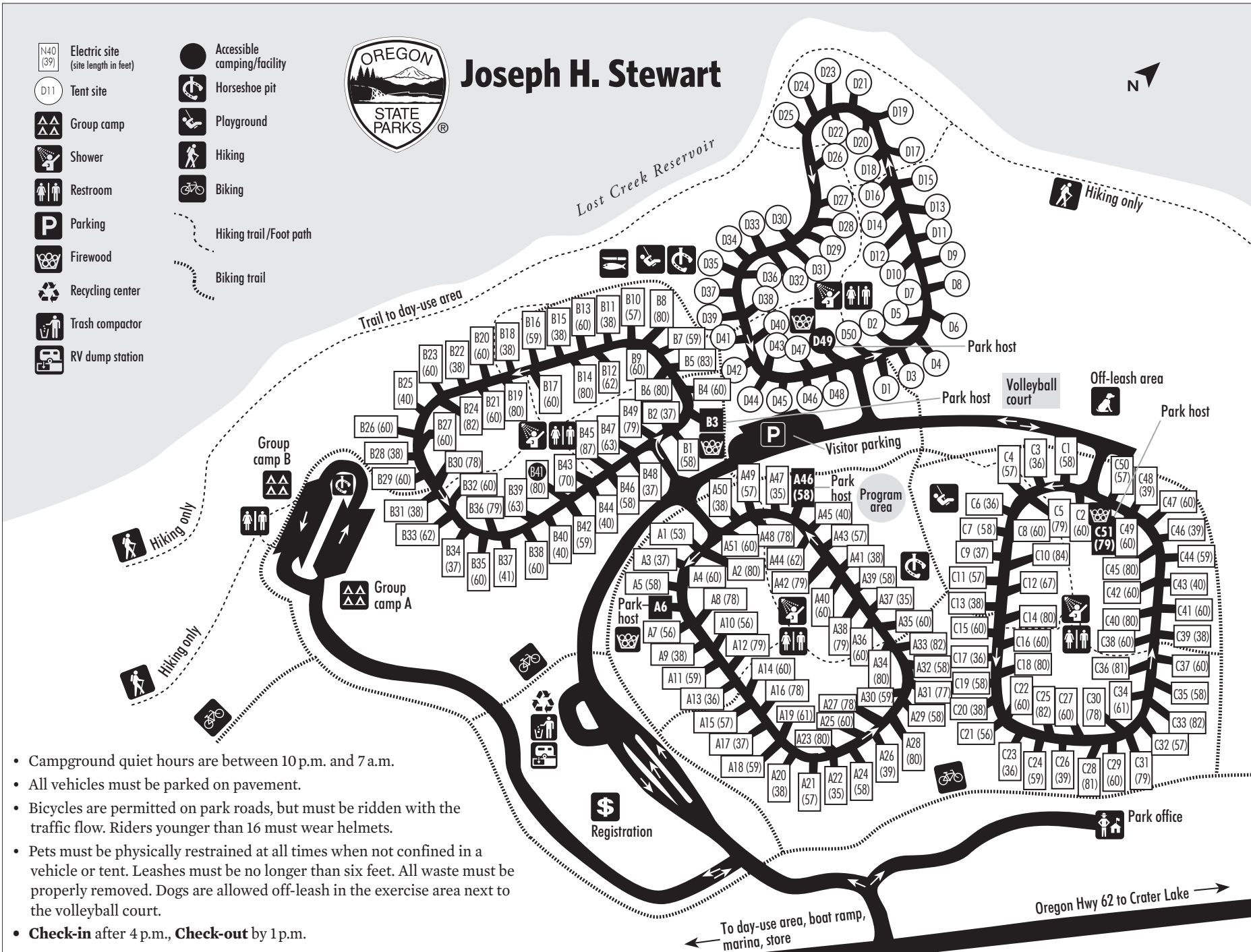

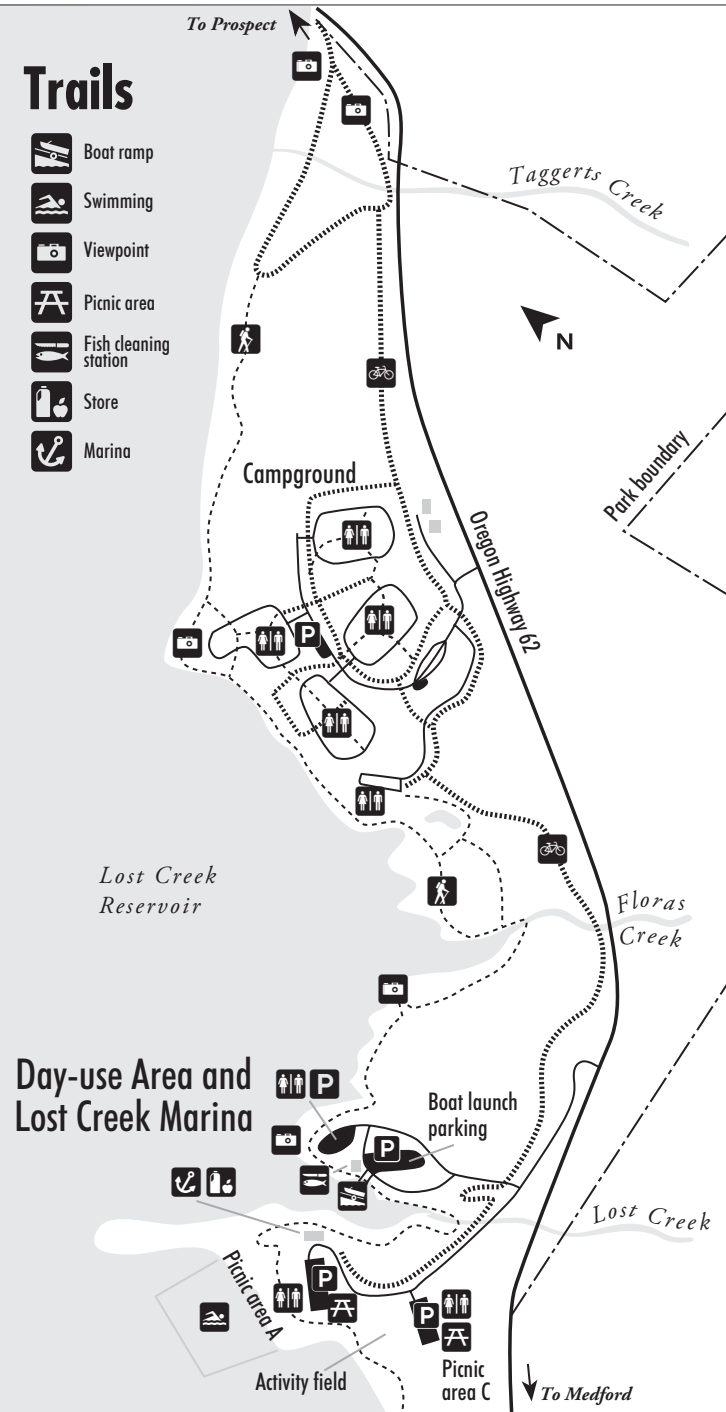

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- All vehicles must be parked on pavement.
- Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but must be ridden with the traffic flow. Riders younger than 16 must wear helmets.
- Pets must be physically restrained at all times when not confined in a vehicle or tent. Leashes must be no longer than six feet. All waste must be properly removed. Dogs are allowed off-leash in the exercise area next to the volleyball court.
- **Check-in** after 4 p.m., **Check-out** by 1 p.m.
