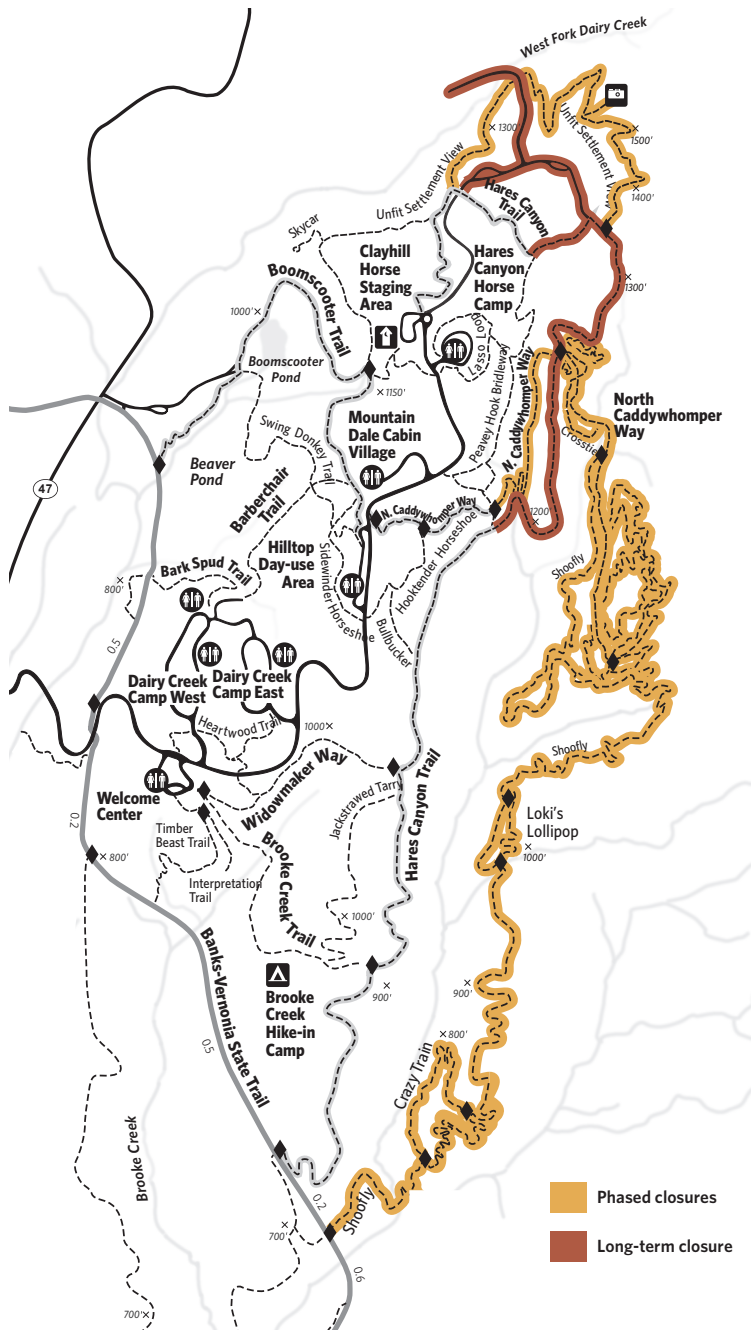




L.L. Stub Stewart State Park

FOREST HEALTH PROJECT TRAIL CLOSURES



Workers will remove trees in phases to improve the overall health of the forest through December 2024.

The park remains open, but trail closures will be in place at different times. The phased work means not all trails will be closed at the same time. The work is in a 164-acre area, primarily in the eastern section of the park.

TRAILS AFFECTED

The following trails may be fully or partially closed:

- **North Caddywhomper Way**
- **Shoofly Trail** and all intersecting trails
- **Unfit Settlement View Trail**

The following trails will be under a long-term closure for the duration of the project:

- **Hares Canyon Trail** between the Peavey Hook Bridleway junction and the junction of Unfit Settlement Trail
